CLASSIC COCKTAILS

Classic Martini

A classic Martini is made with gin (or vodka) and dry vermouth, garnished with a lemon twist or olive.

The classic Martini originated in the late 19th century, with its creation often attributed to bartender Jerry Thomas in California or New York. It evolved from earlier gin and vermouth cocktails into the dry, sophisticated drink popularized in the 20th century.

Singapore Sling

A refreshing cocktail made with gin, cherry brandy, pineapple juice, bitters, and sparkling water.

The Singapore Sling was created around 1915 by bartender Ngiam Tong Boon at the Raffles Hotel in Singapore as a fruity gin cocktail for female guests. Over time, it became a global icon, associated with the hotel's colonial elegance and exotic charm.

Negroni

A classic cocktail made with equal parts gin, Campari, and sweet vermouth.

The Negroni was created in 1919 when Count Camillo Negroni asked a bartender in Florence to make his Americano cocktail stronger by adding gin instead of soda water. The result became an iconic mix of gin, vermouth rosso, and Campari.

Cosmopolitan

A Cosmopolitan is a sleek cocktail made with vodka, triple sec, and cranberry juice.

The Cosmopolitan became popular in the 1980s, often credited to bartender Cheryl Cook, who created it in Miami. It gained global fame in the 1990s, largely through its association with the TV show Sex and the City.

Sex On The Beach

A vibrant cocktail made with vodka, peach schnapps, orange juice, and cranberry juice.

The Sex on the Beach cocktail was created in the 1980s, with several bartenders claiming to have invented it. It became widely popular in the 1990s, thanks to its fruity flavor and association with beach parties and vibrant nightlife.

Caipirinha

A Brazilian cocktail made with cachaça, lime, and brown sugar.

The Caipirinha is Brazil's national cocktail, dating back to the early 20th century, originally made as a remedy using cachaça, lime, and sugar. It became internationally recognized in the 1990s, embodying the spirit of Brazilian culture and festivities.

Mai Tai

A Mai Tai is a tropical cocktail made with dark rum, white rum, triple sec, lime juice, and pineapple juice.

The Mai Tai is a classic cocktail that originated in the 1940s, often attributed to tiki bars in California or Hawaii. It combines rum, lime juice, orgeat syrup, and a hint of mint, becoming a symbol of exotic cocktails in the mid-20th century.

Mojito

A refreshing cocktail made with white rum, fresh mint, sugar, lime, and soda water.

The Mojito is a Cuban cocktail dating back to the 16th century, originally made with indigenous ingredients like rum, lime, and mint. It became popular worldwide after being favored by writer Ernest Hemingway in the 1940s.

Pina Colada

A tropical cocktail made with white rum, Malibu, pineapple juice, and coconut milk.

The Piña Colada originated in Puerto Rico in the 1950s, with various bartenders claiming to have created it. It combines rum, coconut cream, and pineapple juice, becoming a tropical cocktail icon.

Manhattan

A classic cocktail made with whiskey, sweet vermouth, and bitters.

The Manhattan cocktail was created in the 1860s at the Manhattan Club in New York, reportedly for a banquet hosted by politician Samuel Tilden. It traditionally combines whiskey, sweet vermouth, and bitters, becoming a staple of classic cocktail culture.

Aperol Spritz

A refreshing cocktail made with Aperol, Prosecco, and Soda.

The Aperol Spritz originated in Italy in the early 20th century, with the drink evolving from a local Venetian tradition of mixing Aperol with Prosecco. It gained widespread popularity in the 2000s as a refreshing, light aperitif.

Old Fashioned

An Old Fashioned is a timeless cocktail made with whiskey, brown sugar, and bitters.

The Old Fashioned dates back to the early 19th century, evolving from a simple whiskey cocktail served at the Pendennis Club in Louisville, Kentucky. It became known as the “Old Fashioned” when drinkers requested the classic recipe over more complex concoctions in the late 1800s.

Margarita

A zesty cocktail made with tequila, triple sec, and lime juice.

The Margarita is believed to have been created in Mexico in the 1930s or 1940s, with several stories about its origin, including one involving a bartender named Carlos “Danny” Herrera. It combines tequila, lime juice, and orange liqueur, becoming one of the world’s most popular cocktails.

Gimlet

A simple cocktail made with gin, lime juice, and sugar syrup.

The Gimlet dates back to the late 19th century, often attributed to British naval officers who used it to prevent scurvy by mixing gin with lime juice. It became popular in the 20th century, especially after being featured in Raymond Chandler’s detective novels.

Champagne Cocktail

A bubbly drink made with chilled Champagne, Hennessy VS, sugar cube soaked in Angostura bitters, garnished with a lemon twist.

The Champagne cocktail originated in the mid-19th century, famously appearing in Jerry Thomas’s 1862 book “How to Mix Drinks.” Traditionally, it’s a simple yet elegant combination of Champagne, sugar, bitters, and a citrus twist.

Bellini

A refreshing blend of Prosecco and white peach puree, often garnished with a peach slice, known for its fruity and effervescent taste.

The Bellini, invented by Giuseppe Cipriani at Harry’s Bar in Venice during the 1940s, is a mix of Prosecco and white peach puree. Named after painter Giovanni Bellini, its distinct pink hue mirrored the tones in Bellini’s artwork.

Aperitifs are designed to prepare the palate for the meal ahead, so they are generally light and have a refreshing quality. They can be served neat, on the rocks, or mixed into cocktails

The origin of the word “rum” is unclear. The most widely accepted hypothesis is that it is related to “rumbullion”, a beverage made from boiling sugar cane stalks, or possibly “rumbustion,” which was a slang word for “uproar” or “tumult”; a noisy uncontrollable exuberance, though the origin of those words and the nature of the relationship are unclear. Both words surfaced in English about the same time as rum did (1651 for “rumbullion”, and before 1654 “rum”).
